I'm drawn to this role because it describes how I already work, not something I aspire to. I own AI products from concept to production, and I build them myself, with exactly the stack you list: LLMs, APIs, automation, AI agents, RAG, vector databases, and orchestration frameworks. As Head of AI I own the vision and roadmap, turn strategy into prioritized plans and business outcomes, and ship real software rather than handing specifications to others. I built and operate Agent Squad AI, a cluster of autonomous agents doing real work in production, and under my leadership the company reached Registered Partner status in Anthropic's partner program. That is what lets me tell a good AI bet from a bad one, because I see this technology deliver and break in production every day.

What may set me apart for K2 University is that I have lived both sides of learning. I am a founding professor of an innovation chair and have taught at masters level, so when you say AI must enhance learning outcomes and not just content delivery, that is a distinction I feel, not a slogan. I know the difference between an AI tutor that actually teaches and a copilot that only serves content, and I bring that judgment to the AI products I build. Around that I bring fifteen years of enterprise delivery, taking critical platforms from concept to production, running successful launches with content, technical, and business teams, and prioritizing by value and impact when everything looks urgent. At NTT DATA I led the office's largest account and shipped a digital origination platform in phases, escalating dependencies early so a launch was never a surprise.

Two points of candor. My formal titles have been in AI and delivery leadership rather than a career product owner, though I own AI products end to end for real, today. And on SAP, I am not an SAP implementer. My exposure is an earlier presales engineering role for an SAP Business One partner, enough to have real familiarity with the SAP Business One ecosystem while I bring the AI depth the role is really built around. What I can guarantee is the core of the job: building with modern AI, shipping from concept to production, owning outcomes, and making AI improve how people actually learn. I would be glad to show you what I have built. Thank you for your time.
